Camp #1 – JUNIOR SPECIALTY CAMP (ages 7-10) Sunday July 3 – Friday July 8

\$260 (\$270) after May 1st for Arts, Dynamic Pursuit or Crazy Bowls
\$300 (\$310) for golf

All Specialty Camps allows campers to choose one of three specialty areas, Arts, Dynamic Pursuit, or Crazy Bowls, which they will spend three hours at each morning. The afternoons will be spent rotating to other favourite areas of camp. Arts will include arts, crafts, music, dance and drama. Dynamic Pursuit will include sports, swimming, and archery. Crazy Bowls will include cooking, baking and kitchen safety. Off-site option is: Golf at Sunset Golf Course. The Golf option includes three hours at Sunset with club rental, instruction and time each day spent on the Baby Boomer Golf Academy Par 3 course. Registration is between 3-4 pm on Sunday and pick up time is at 7 pm on Friday. Family members are invited to join us at 6:45 pm for closing campfire.

CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT

- Parents/Guardians are responsible for transportation to and from camp.
 - If your child is unable to attend camp due to an unforeseen circumstance, all but \$25 per camper will be refunded.
 - The Director reserves the right to dismiss any camper who in her opinion demonstrates a hazard to the safety and/or well being of the camp, himself/herself, or others, as well as any camper who does not adhere to the rules and regulations of the camp. Campers dismissed under these circumstances will not be given a refund.
 - Campers sent home due to homesickness will not be given a refund.
 - All registrations include a camp photo and t-shirt.
 - Camp Menesetung is a smoke and alcohol free-site.
- ## WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP
- Sleeping bag, pillow, blanket, PJ's and flashlight
 - **Hat** and **sunscreen** and **water bottle**
 - Clothing for hot days, cold days and wet days
 - A change of shoes and a pair of boots
 - Swim wear (no bikinis), beach towel and raincoat
 - Long sleeve t-shirt and long pants for night time "bug wear" and bug spray
 - Personal items: comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, towel, washcloth and shampoo
 - Medications, if any. If your child is taking medication such as Ritalin, continuation at camp is strongly recommended.
 - A Bible, if you have one

WHAT NOT TO BRING TO CAMP

Electronic equipment (cell phones, IPODS, walkmans, CD players, hand held games, tapes or CDs), bikinis, money, water guns and visitors are not permitted at camp.
